It will also establish a blood "titer standard" to provide a scientific basis to avoid unnecessary rabies boosters. Phase Two will study veterinary vaccine additives (like aluminum, mercury and fetal calf tissue) and will establish a much needed federal adverse reaction reporting system. **This project is completely funded by donations from concerned pet lovers like you.**
